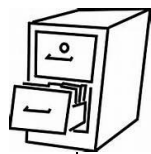

6+1 Traits* of Writing with Writing Process



SENTENCE FLUENCY:

- Sentences flow well
- Varied Types
- Varied Structure/Openers
- Varied Lengths



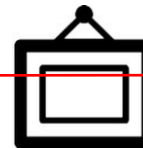
WORD CHOICE:

- Matches Audience (in formality, level, relevance)
- Precise & Accurate
- Effective: powerful, creative
- Repetition: purposeful
- No Redundancy or Wordiness



CONVENTIONS (SMOG):

- Spelling
- Mechanics (Punctuation, Capitalization)
- Overuse (Check)
- Grammar



FORMATTING (+1):

- Font Style/Size
- White Space
- Text Features (Subtitles, etc.)
- Graphics
- Handwriting
- Formal Standards (MLA, etc.)
