Mar 23 – Early May	Initial Registration Begins - Course Selection & Schedule Availability Inputs (no payment yet)
By End of May	Course Schedule Available Based on Registration Inputs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Payment Due for Registered Families by 2 Weeks After Course Schedule Notification Email Sent - For Families Registered by May 1, IXL Access Begins for Optional Use on ~ June 1
By Aug 1	Class-Specific Welcome Email Sent to Registered & Paid Students
Aug 8	Last Day of Fall Reg & Payment for No Late Fee (late registration on a case-by-case basis with a \$75 late fee)
Aug 10 - 15	* Fall Launch Readiness Review (LRR) Week for All Classes
Aug 17	Fall Year-Long (32 weeks) Classes Start
Sept 7	Labor Day – Typically Pre-recorded Classes Due to Families’ Vacations (But Monday Classes Will Decide)
Oct 12	Columbus Day – Typically Pre-recorded Classes (But Monday Classes Will Decide)
TBD Week in Oct	Fall Break – One Week in October With No Classes (NOTE – 1 week in October will also be fully online)
Nov 1	Daylight Savings Time Ends
Nov 11	Veterans Day Federal Holiday – Typically Pre-recorded Classes (But Wednesday Classes Will Decide)
Nov 23 - 27	Thanksgiving Break – No Classes
Dec 14 - 18	Last Week of Fall Semester for Year-Long Classes (16 weeks) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Week 16 (the last week) of each semester is online Zoom office hours only (no formal classes) for students to ask questions and prepare for the final test
Dec 31	Fall Grades Complete

NOTES:

- * LAUNCH READINESS REVIEW (LRR) WEEK – The week before classes start, each class has an online LRR meeting to meet each other, verify electronic tools work well, and answer any questions.
 - In general, the LRR online meeting for each class is the same day & time as the first class of the semester.
 - Students with schedule conflicts can watch the recording, attend another class’s LRR, or stop by online office hours.

FEDERAL HOLIDAYS – Classes are typically via recording only for federal holidays, but classes will decide.

RESERVE WEEK – While each semester generally has one reserve week included to allow for weather challenges, teacher illness, etc., for Fall 2026 the reserve week will be used during a TBD week in October.
